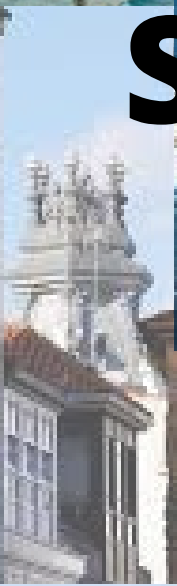
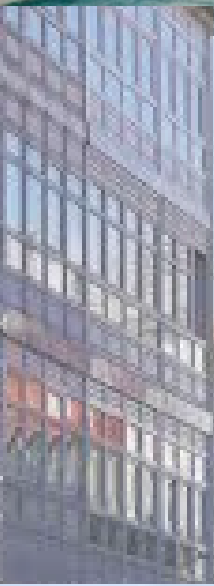

# About A Coruña

A Coruña is a friendly town of about 250,000 people on the North-West coast of mainland Spain where nobody is considered a foreigner (that's the city's motto). A peninsula immersed in the sea, it is famous for its quietness, cultural activity, food, long sea promenade, authentic atmosphere and animated night life.

It is a city where everything is within walking distance, but where things keep happening. Mixing the old with the new, you can walk around an old city area full of monuments and history and then go for a swim in the very modern area of Orzán-Riazor urban beaches, only 5 minutes away.

In the summer, there are different festivals and amenities, such as San Juan bonfire night (June 23rd) on the beach, which attracts visitors from everywhere. The Coruñese love to be outdoors enjoying other people's company, love meeting new people and sharing their life with newcomers, so you will never be in want of company.
